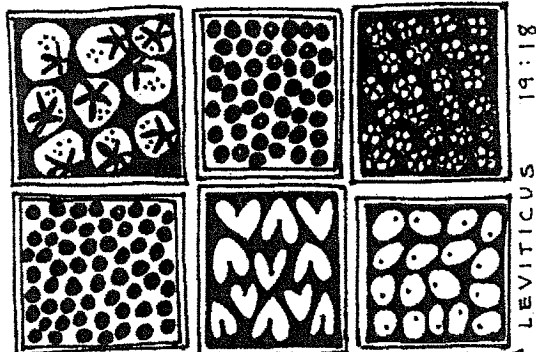

Notes on the text

N*o one who sets a hand to the plow . . . is fit for the kingdom of God.* The gospel takes commitment to a call one better than the first reading. At least Elijah gave Elisha a chance to bid his parents good-bye. But Jesus told his followers not to take time for such a leave-taking, or even, shockingly, to bury a dead parent.

The Sunday gospels now turn toward Jesus' journey to Jerusalem in Luke, and Christ takes both his disciples and the whole church with him. In travelling with Jesus as his followers—those willing to serve, love, and sacrifice themselves—we pledge ourselves to sweep away all that separates us from living the gospel with all our wills and hearts. We not only let go of the plow but, like Elisha, we burn it with the fire of the Pentecost season.
