### *Notes on the text*

**I** *tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.* Jesus tells series of brief stories to illustrate God's relationship to human beings especially in terms of prayer. The friend who visits at midnight gets what he needs through his "persistence," just as God will hear those who persist in prayer. The next stories illustrate how ridiculous it would be to think that God might do something like give stones for bread or a scorpion for an egg. Rather, God responds to the needs of God's children. All people have to do is ask. But this knocking at God's door does not mean God will grant our every wish. Jesus puts *asking* together with *seeking*. To seek God requires much more commitment than a simple request. Intercession flows from a total relationship to God.
