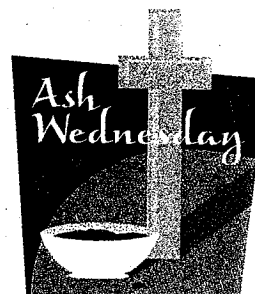

### LENTEN REMINDERS & SCHEDULE

The season of Lent begins Wednesday, February 25. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast (ages 18-59) and abstinence (14 years and older): abstaining from meat and eating one full meal that day for those who are not excused or dispensed. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

Mass with the dispensing of ashes will be at 7:00 am and 7:30 pm on Ash Wednesday.

Stations of the Cross will be held each Friday evening at 7:00 pm preceded by a Soup Supper at 6:00 pm in the RE Building. Mass will follow the Stations of the Cross.

Masses on Wednesdays during Lent will be at 8:00 am. No Mass on Wednesday evenings.

Please join us once again for our Lenten Soup Supper each Friday of Lent at 6:00 pm before the Stations of the Cross. This supper is offered at no charge, although donations will be accepted to benefit the building project. If you would like to bring soup, sign up sheets are located on the tables at the back of church.
