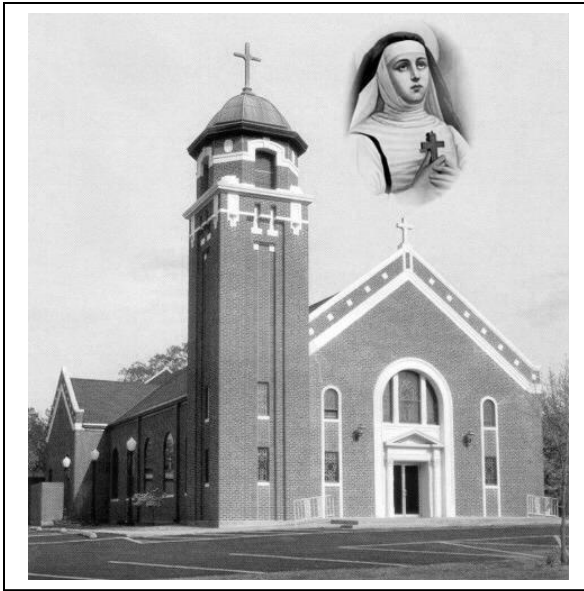

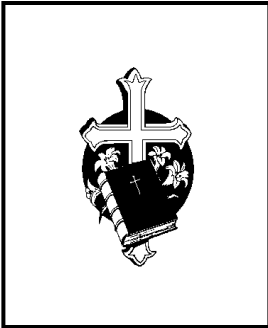

Oklahoma Catholic Women to hold Conference

Oklahoma catholic women are invited to spend a day of reflection, healing and renewal at the Oklahoma Catholic Women's Conference in February, The fourth annual conference will be held on Saturday, February 6 at the Clarion Conference Center at I-40 and Meridian in Oklahoma City. The conference will include a morning mass with Archbishop Eusebius Beltran, Adoration, Reconciliation and a vendor area. Both on-line and mail-in registrations begin now. Four sessions featuring nationally known speakers have been scheduled and vendors have contracted to set up booth selling books, clothing and religious items. Through January 22, the registration fee is \$50 and \$30 for students, and includes a box lunch and drink. After January 22, the registration fee is \$60, and will be accepted as space permits. Registrations can be submitted on the conference web site using PayPal, or by mailing in a registration form available on the web site or in the parish office.
