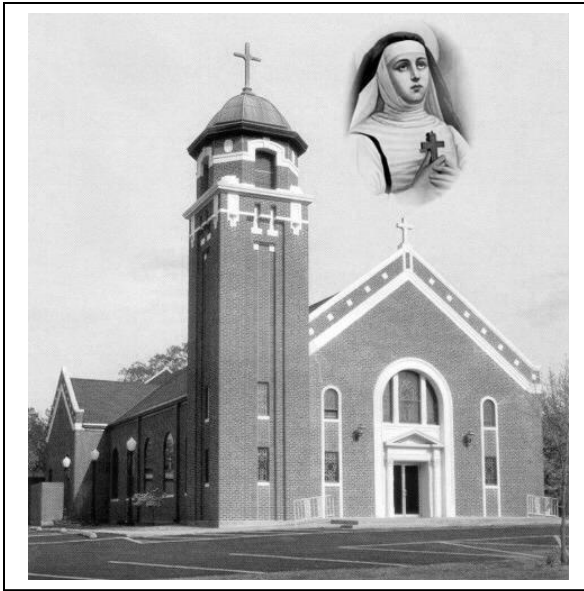

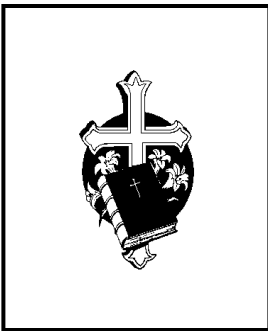

MLK CELEBRATION - The 7th annual celebration to honor the work of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., will be held **Mon., Jan. 18**, at Corpus Christi Church, Oklahoma City. A multicultural celebration will be held at 11 a.m. Archbishop Beltran will be the principal celebrant for the noon liturgy. The event is sponsored by Catholic Charities, the Commission for Justice and Human Development and Corpus Christi Parish. All are welcome.

SANCTITY OF LIFE MASS - The **Sanctity of Life Mass** will be held **Wed., Jan. 20**, at Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help at 6 p.m. The Mass will be celebrated by Archbishop Eusebius J. Beltran. The faithful are invited to join in the praying for the value of life in remembrance of the Supreme Court case of Roe vs. Wade, which legalized abortion. Programs to discuss Catholic social teaching about the dignity of human life will follow. For teens, the discussion will be facilitated by Rev. Bill Novak, pastor of St. John Nepomuk Church, Yukon, and for adults by Rev. Stephen Hamilton, pastor of Sts. Peter and Paul, Kingfisher. Refreshments will be served.
