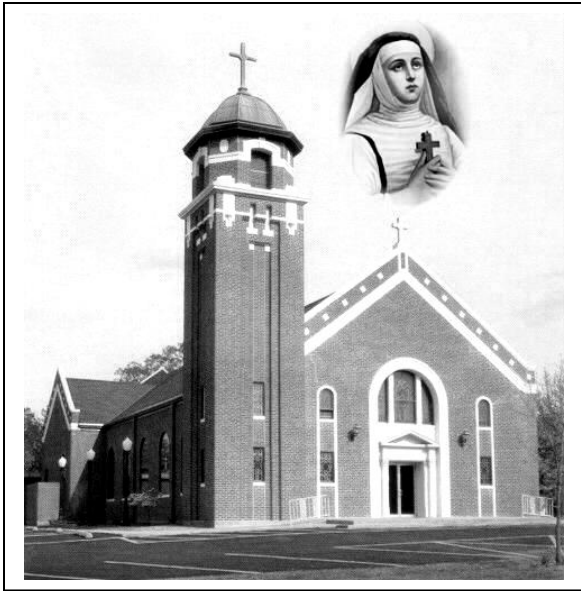

Scan Specialists will be at St. Teresa performing 9 ultrasound screenings on **Monday, June 21, 2010** (Day & Evening appointments will be available). If you have high blood pressure or high cholesterol, diabetes, or you have family history of heart disease, stroke, or internal cancers please consider the ultrasound screening for early detection.

They will scan the arteries in the neck, the main artery off of the heart, the thyroid, liver, spleen, kidneys, gallbladder, and the arteries in the legs.

These screenings are typically **NOT** performed at annual check-ups, nor will insurance companies pay for them unless you are symptomatic. Collectively, these screenings cost thousands. They will be offering these screenings to you for \$45 each or \$189 for all nine combined. Insurance is **NOT** necessary to receive the discount. Pre-Registration **IS** necessary and appointments are limited. Please call 1- 800- 931-4772 to schedule an appointment today.
