

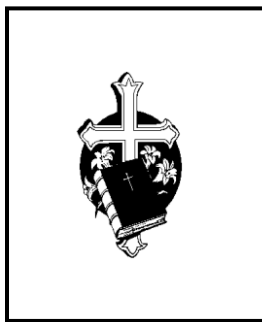

❖ I encourage and request all of you to come to church fully and properly dressed.

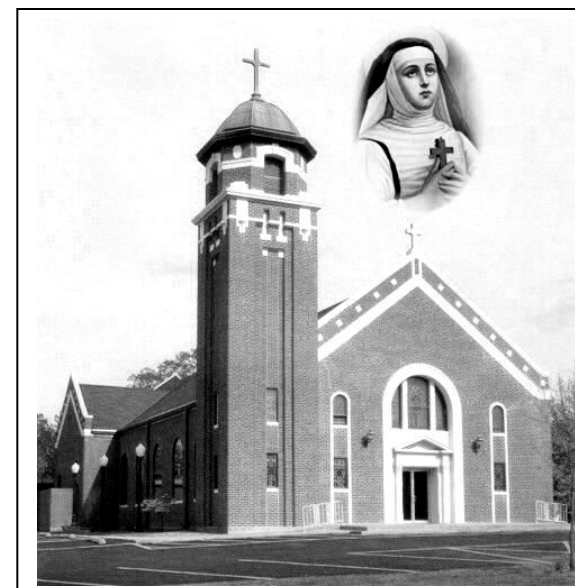
