St. GREGORY'S UNIVERSITY BENEDICTINE HALL RESTORATION

COLLECTION

Archbishop Paul Coakley and Bishop Slattery have authorized a special collection March 3-4, 2012 in support of the Benedictine Hall Restoration Fund at St. Gregory's University. As you likely know, the building sustained major damage as a result of the 5.6 magnitude earthquake that struck the state in November. Benedictine Hall is the main academic and administrative building on campus and is listed in the National Registry of Historic Places. The cost to fully restore Benedictine Hall to its former glory is estimated at \$2.8 million. The university has raised \$1.5 million through support from alumni and friends throughout the country. You can pledge your support by giving to the restoration fund in March. Envelopes may be found in the pews or in back of the Church.

MARCH FOR LIFE

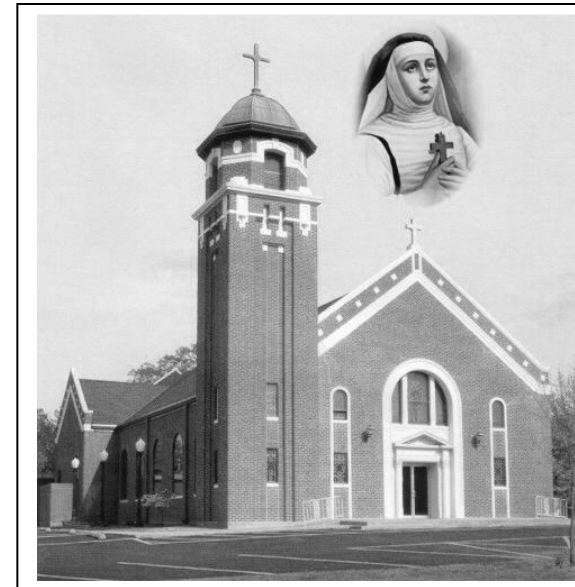
