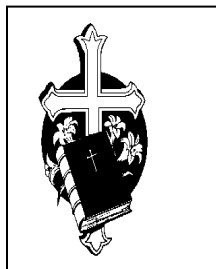

PARISH COUNCIL ELECTION

Scott Manwell will be running for re-election, but the position is open for any qualifying parishioner who would like to run for St. Teresa's Parish Council. Nominations may be made by the candidate or by another parishioner who has obtained the written consent of the prospective candidate. Deadline for nominations shall be May 27, 2012. Election will be June 16 & 17. If a runoff is needed it will be June 23 & 24, newly elected member shall take office as of the first day of the month following their election. All members of the Parish, eighteen years of age or older, who are in communion of faith and life with the Roman Catholic Church shall be eligible for membership on the Parish Council and are eligible to vote in parish election.

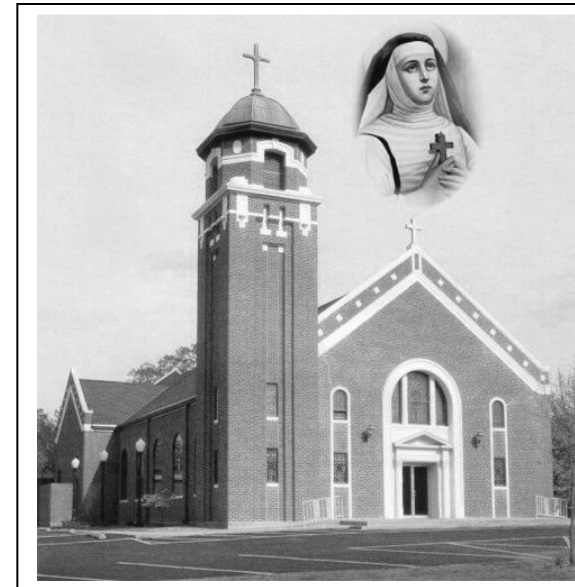
