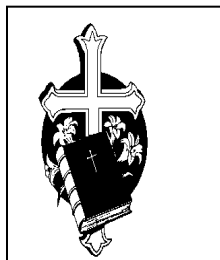

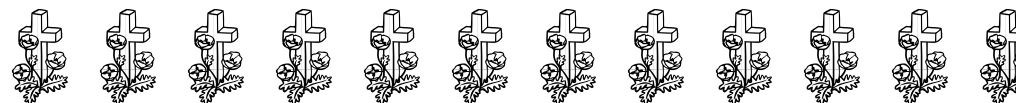
YOUTH GROUP TIME CHANGES

In the United States, a Red Mass for judges, attorneys and government officials is traditionally celebrated to coincide with the convening of the United States Supreme Court on the first Monday in October. (The Red Mass takes its name from the red vestments worn at the Mass, symbolic of the tongues of fire that descended on the Apostles at Pentecost.)

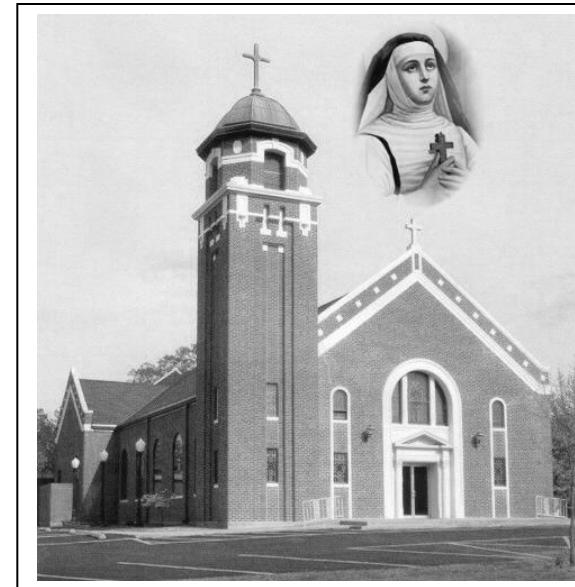
