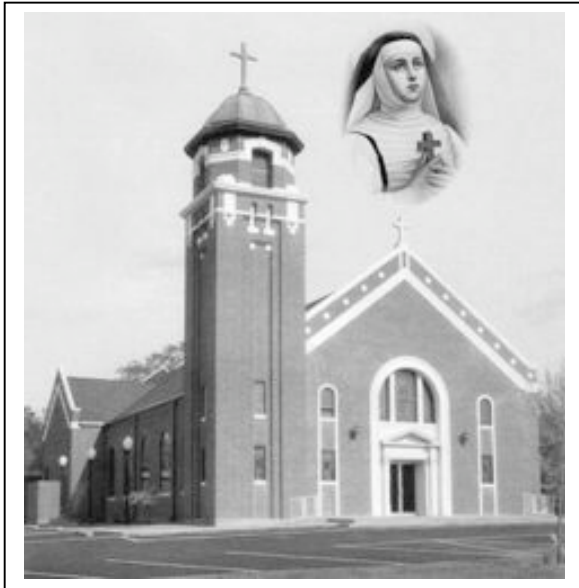

SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

Your parish’s St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) Society and the National and State SVdP provide assistance to the May tornado victims. They responded to the tornados by processing applications for long term assistance, providing an information clearing house for other available assistance and by giving over 2,500 Wal-Mart gift cards. This work was done at sites in Moore, Norman, El Reno, Little Ax and Shawnee. Your parish SVdP, with the help of several parishioners, ran the SVdP operation at Shawnee. During that time we travelled 1,480 miles, working 215 hours assisted 89 families and gave out \$4500 in gift cards. SVdP, Red Cross, Catholic Charities and Knights of Columbus will continue to assist victims until they are back in a home. Thank You for your generous donations of money, food or time. You make our work possible.
