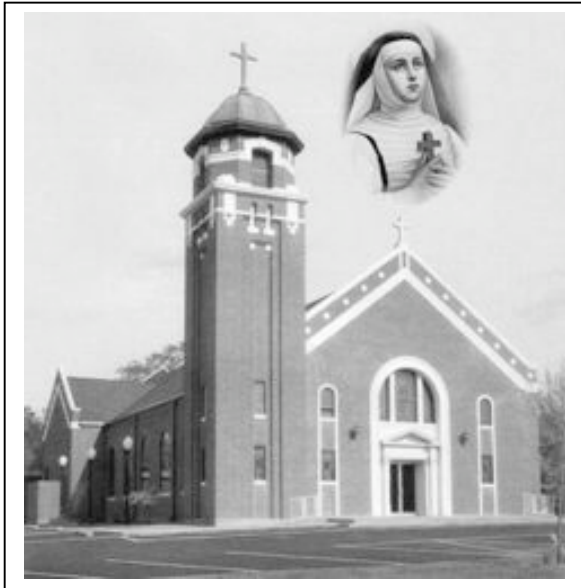

Faith Community Nursing is a recognized specialty practice for registered nurses that combines professional nursing and health ministry. This is an independent nursing practice where the nurse performs roles of educator, referral agenda, advocate, personal health counselor, developer of support groups, volunteer coordinator and integrator of faith and health. The course fee is \$450 which includes tuition, materials, CEU's, IPNRC pin, meals, and first year membership in Faith Community Nurses Association of Oklahoma (FCNA OK).
