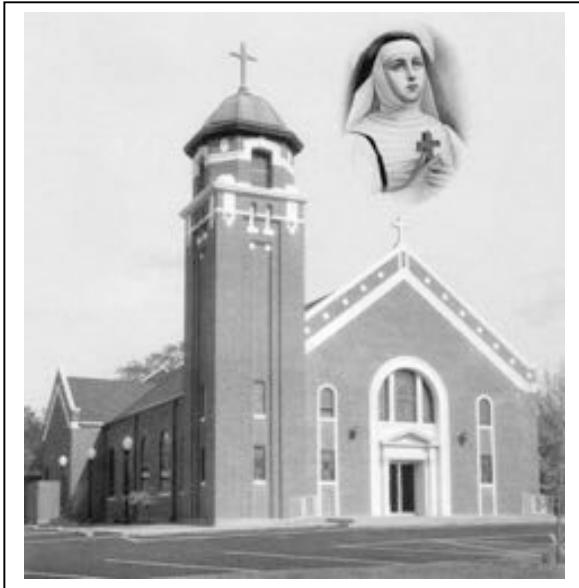

(Dead line for nominations is May 31, 2015. List of persons running will be put in the bulletin or announced 6th and 7th of June. Election will be June 13, 14, 2015, if a runoff is needed it will be June 20, 21, 2015.) All newly elected members of the council shall take office as of the first day of the month following their election
