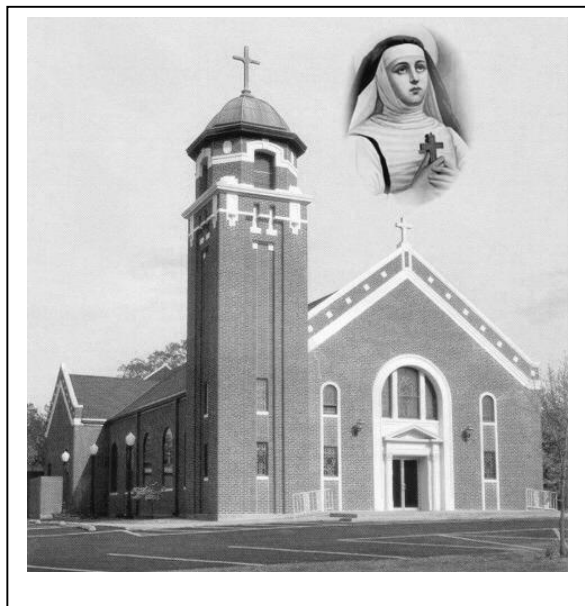

From the Pastor's Desk

- At a wedding feast at Cana, Christ performed the first of the seven signs (miracles) recounted in the Gospel of John. The wanting wine threatens to spoil the celebration of new love. But the Mother of God notices the need and speaks to her Son. With one word from his Mother, Jesus reveals his divinity so that, just as a bridegroom rejoices in his bride, all people can realize just how much our God rejoices in us. Just as it did for his first disciples, this revelation of glory leads us to deeper belief in Christ. The miracle of "good wine" continues through the outpouring of the spiritual gifts of the Holy Spirit to each individual.
- Just as our breath is the life of our body, so also the one Spirit of God enlivens the one Body of Christ. Our lives are not our own, though. We live to pour them out in service of God and neighbor, as Christ pours out his life to bring us to life in the water of baptism and the wine of the Eucharist. Let us serve the life and needs of the Body with all our gifts for the praise and glory of God.
