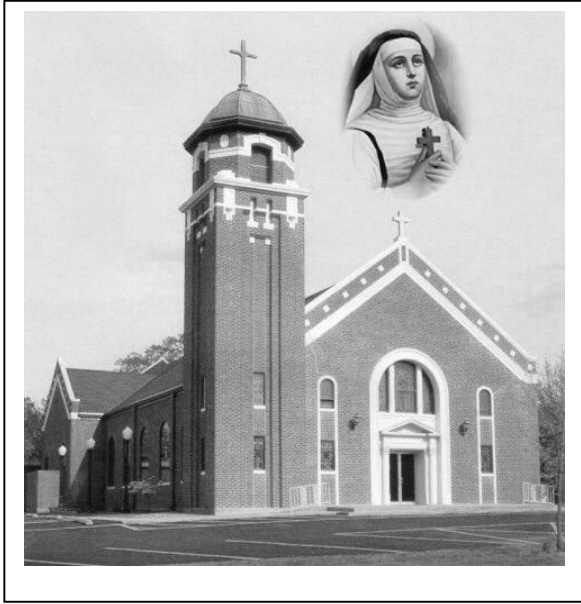

- "Obedience forms the core of Jesus' being" (Romano Guardini).
