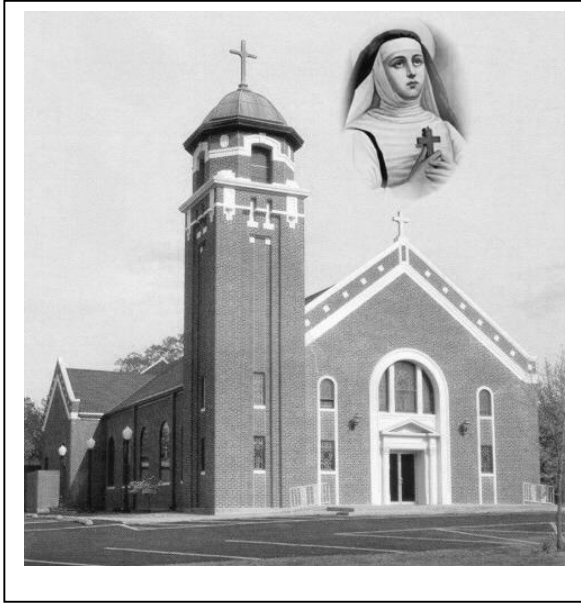

At his installation as Pope on March 19, 2013, Pope Francis preached the following words, which show us why we as a Church reject abortion and euthanasia, which kill the vulnerable rather than protect them: "The vocation of being a "protector" is not just something involving us Christians alone; it also has a prior dimension which is simply human, involving everyone.
