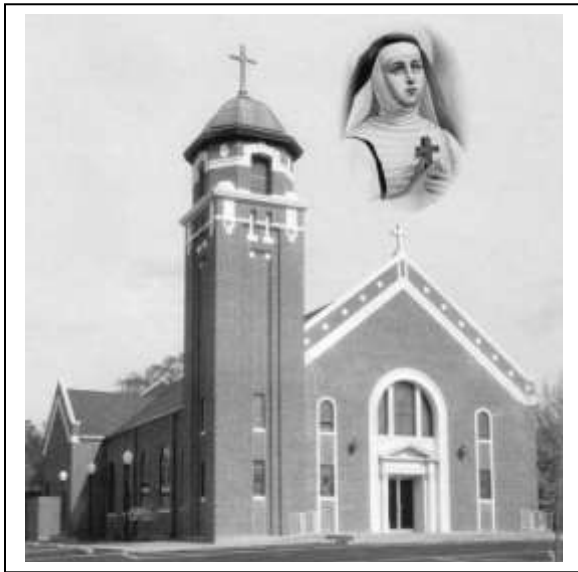

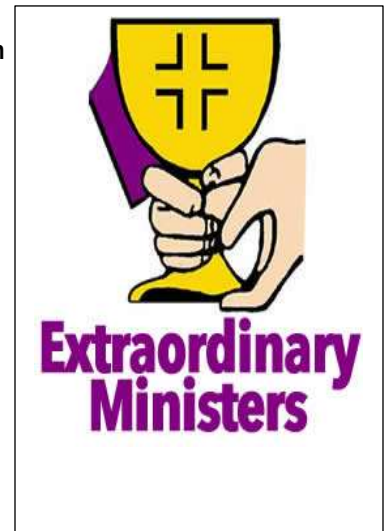

Statement regarding the removal from ministry of Fr. James Mickus

Archbishop Coakley on Nov. 4 announced the removal of Fr. James Mickus from ministry pending investigation of an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor. Fr. Mickus serves as pastor of Our Lady of Sorrows in Chandler and Saint Louis in Stroud. The allegation does not involve Fr. Mickus's current parishes. The allegation is under review by the archdiocesan Review Board and an independent firm hired by the archdiocese to review and investigate allegations of abuse by priests from 1960 to 2018.
